



As seen from the Community Hall the new woodland presents a pleasing balance of interlocking broadleaf and conifer areas and sections of open space. In addition, it adds to existing woodland cover along the Annan Water and, in time, will obscure the existing harsh edge of the existing conifer forest above (i.e. to the west of) the A701 and visible on the photographs.



A701 near Larie Linn at NT 060 108 looking SE. This visualisation indicates that the new woodland will not be visible from the A701 at this location further south in the valley.





A701 at Annandale Way crossing at NT 060 115 looking SE. This also shows that the planting has been well set back from the road allowing views out and over the tree canopy towards the hills on the opposite side of the valleys. Broadleaves will predominate in this view with limited glimpses of the conifer areas behind the broadleaves.
