



There are several named waterways within the forest boundary including ; Allt Raineach, Eas na Dunaiche, Allt nan Laogh, and Allt an t Saobhaidh, that lead in to the Abhainn Learg an Uinnsinn/ Allt Caoi-rain river, which is currently in good condition.

Forest and water guidelines will be followed to maintain this status

There is opportunity to improve connectivity and habitats for wildlife through, for example, the creation or enhancement of wildlife corridors, planting of native species, designed open ground and linking riparian areas.

Opportunity for phased felling and restructuring to increase age class diversity

Opportunity to improve riparian zone throughout the forest, by buffering watercourses from planting conifers in subsequent rotations

There is potential for protected species to be present in the forest, for example, badgers, red squirrel, pine marten and raptors. Restructuring of the forest provides opportunity for habitat enhancement which will benefit a range of species, for example, through the planting of a more diverse selection of tree species and identifying areas of the forest that may be suitable for long term retention.

Pre-operational wildlife surveys will be carried out to detect signs of any species and habitats, and appropriate mitigations will be put in place

Japanese larch will be felled and replanted with alternative conifers and/or native mixed broadleaves as appropriate

The forest is predominantly of a mature even-aged character. Phased felling and restructuring will provide an opportunity to diversify the age structure and species composition to enhance landscape character and biodiversity for example, linking habitats and buffering remnant broadleaves to connect with the open hill.

These measures will ensure that the forest will be compliant with the requirements of the United Kingdom Forest Standard by the end of the plan period.
