

Forest Development Types
A "Forest Development Type" is a long-term vision of how the species composition and structure of a forest stand is intended to develop. Forest Development Types can range from single species, even aged stands managed largely under a clearfelling and restocking regime, to stands with a diverse species, structure and age class distribution managed under Continuous Cover Forestry Management.

The system has been developed by Forest Research and defines a number of Forest Development Types, each one describing a target stand structure and composition, and with defined climate and site suitability.

A number of Forest Development Types are proposed at Haddo Estate indicated by the 'target notes' and described in the accompanying document.
